### Why play PTDA?

New Jersey is a hotbed of youth soccer development with numerous opportunities for children to play at a wide variety of skill levels. The PTDA program offers your child an early taste of the great sport of soccer. If they discover that soccer is their passion, participating in the PTDA program is the first step in developing the skills necessary to excel. It is also great fun and the kids love it! Ask anyone who has participated.

### What is the PTDA structure?

- Small-team/small-field play – LOTS of playing time and LOTS of chances to learn soccer!
- PROFESSIONAL COACHES! UK Elite coaches will run all practice sessions and games.
- Two sessions a week- Session one: a team training session followed by a game. Session two: additional foot skills training session
- A curriculum that teaches the fundamentals necessary for success in travel soccer.
- Fall and Spring season: registration fee of \$190 covers all costs from September to June.
- Play soccer without giving up other sports! To the best of our ability, the PTDA will be scheduled so as not to interfere with baseball and other sports.
- No tryouts – all players are accepted!
- SEPARATE PLAY FOR BOYS AND GIRLS!
- PTDA players are given priority for travel soccer slots at U9 (3<sup>rd</sup> Grade) level.

### What are the program requirements?

- Players will need to buy their own soccer shoes, socks, and shin guards. All other equipment included.
- Cost is \$190 for both Fall and Spring Sessions
- Sessions start September 2011. Fall sessions are Fridays, 4:00 – 5:30 PM.  
Spring Sessions Saturdays 9 to 10:30 AM.
